S.K.I.P Child ID Program



The Safe Kids Identification Program, known as SKIP, is a computer program that allows parents to quickly transfer significant missing child information to the police for an Amber Alert when their child is lost or abducted.

Most comprehensive child identification program available.

Stores two photographs of the child: front view and side profile.

Collects vital statistics such as height, weight, hair/eye color, scars.

Parents continually keep photographs & information current at home.

Stores records of medical issues, child custody orders, disabilities.

Create, print and **email** Missing Child Posters to police & media.

Parents can make back-up copies for travel or to share with family.

Includes a Toothprint dental wafer.
